Across all seats, LNP was down 6%, going equally to Teals, Greens & Others. In Teal contested seats, Teals won 12% - from Libs 6%, ALP 4% & Greens 2%.

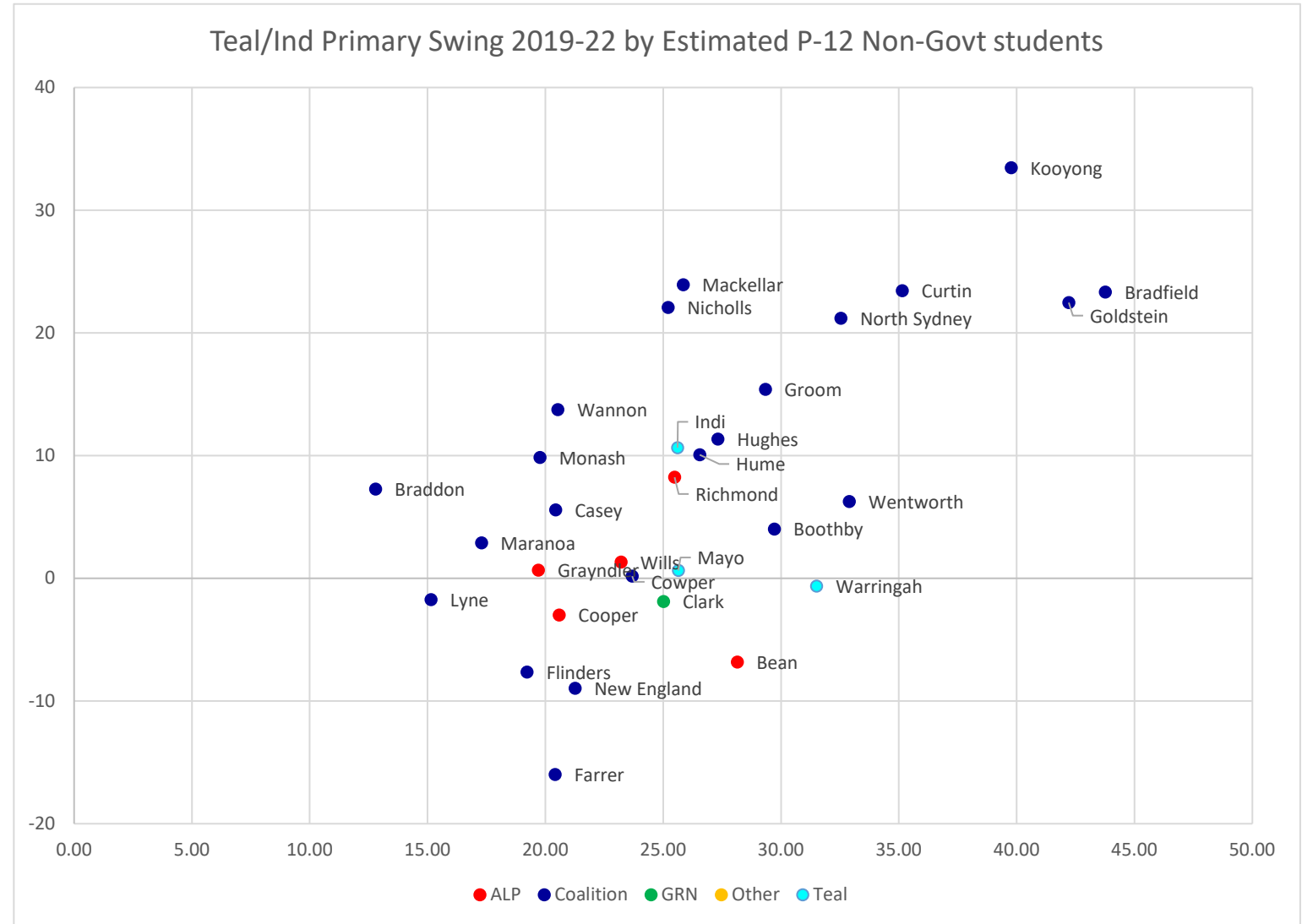

The strongest primary vote swings to the Teal candidates was from parents of students at Non-Government schools.

Scatterplot shows Teal/Ind primary swings (Y axis) by increasing P-12 Non-Govt students (X axis).



The strongest primary vote swings to Teal candidates were in seats dominated by EGS Client schools with high SES catchments.
